January 1, 1923 - March 10, 2021

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Eileen Boyd Hutchinson, the founder of Neville Green. She was 98 years old and passed peacefully in her sleep on March 10, 2021. Eileen became a resident of Neville Island when her husband, Reverend Harry T. Hutchinson, was appointed minister of the Neville Island Presbyterian Church.

Eileen was responsible for the building of the two planting circles at the intersection of Grand Avenue and Neville Road and the triangle planting area at the 79 South ramp. She also created the Neville Naturalists program. Neville Green awards an annual scholarship in her name. She will be missed.

Excerpts from "Heathy Trees For A Healthy Environment"

The powers of trees are as wide and far reaching as one can imagine. From mental and emotional benefits to ecological healing, trees do a lot for us and our world. Some notable benefits include:



Saving Lives:

In the U.S. alone, trees save more than 850 lives and prevent 670,000 incidents of acute respiratory symptoms a year by removing air pollution.



Reducing Noise Pollution:

Trees serve as a beautiful and effective solution to urban noise, with the ability to reduce noise by around 5-10 decibels.



Generating More Oxygen:

The average number of urban trees needed to offset the annual oxygen consumption of one adult is approximately 30 trees; in other words, an acre of trees can provide enough oxygen for eight people.
